INTERNATIONAL**

IN ORDER TO PROCESS YOUR APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION, WE NEED THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- _____ 1) Completed ASUMH on-line application at www.asumh.edu and an International Student Application for Admission.

- _____ 2) Official secondary school transcript/examination results. **ONLY ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS OR COPIES CERTIFIED BY A SCHOOL OR CONSULAR OFFICIAL WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

- _____ 3) Official transcripts of all education beyond the secondary school. **DOCUMENTS MUST BE IN ENGLISH AND SHOW ALL COURSES TAKEN AND GRADES RECEIVED. ONLY ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS OR COPIES CERTIFIED BY A SCHOOL OR CONSULAR OFFICIAL WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

If you are transferring from a college or university outside the United States to ASU, you must send your transcript to either Educational Credential Evaluators, Inc (ECE) or to World Education Services (WES). ECE or WES will evaluate your transcript and let us know how many of your courses are equivalent to courses at ASU. Both companies charge for this service

- _____ 4) Proof of English proficiency. (TOEFL) Applicants must submit a score of 500(paper based) or 173 (computer based exam). Official score report must be mailed directly from ETS to ASUMH. (ASUMH TOEFL Code number is 6057) WWW.ETS.ORG

- _____ 5) Financial statement form, completed and dated no more than six months prior to the date of enrollment. Sponsors must attach an official bank statement which verifies that \$18,666.00 is on deposit in an American bank. Verification of amount of monies required will change if taking summer classes.

- _____ 6) Official score report from ACT or SAT examinations

- _____ 7) Proof of immunization against measles, mumps, and rubella. Two MMR's are required, plus all other immunizations. (See Form)

- _____ 8) Record of current Tuberculin Skin Test (TST) (if results are over 10 mm a chest x-ray is required. (Forms need to be completed)

- _____ 9) Proof of Health Insurance with repatriation requirement on the policy.

The completed applications and ALL supporting documentation must be received in the Admissions Office at least 3 months prior to the desired enrollment date. The applicant will be informed by mail of their admission status.
